If it's train arrangements:

Sending organizations are responsible for the booking of the most direct economic train connection from the participants' city of residence to Skopje/ Kumanovo, Macedonia permitting arrival on February 14 and return on February 22, 2012.

If it's bus arrangements:

Sending organizations are responsible for the booking of the most convenient bus line connection from the participants' city of residence to Kumanovo, Macedonia permitting arrival n February 14 and return on February 22, 2012.

4. PREPARE FOR YOUR TRIP

Be sure to wear comfortable, warm clothes and shoes on the flight which you will also need for the training.

When you travel, be sure to have with you:
